

## RATIONALE AND OBJECTIVES

The *University of MoRón International Thesaurus* (UM-Thesaurus) is a digital edition issued in collaboration with *Domingo Liotta International Foundation*.

The bi-monthly editions are focused on Science and Culture, and the full texts are written in English and in Spanish. Thus, in successive issues, updated information on the new and ever-growing scientific fields is combined either with cultural anecdotic facts or with historical characters. The imaginative conception concerning the whole theory of life dedicated to cultivate minds all over the world.

Consequently, worldwide personalities in the fields of culture, science and humanities are invited to collaborate in the UM Thesaurus to enrich the thought of thousands of registrants around the World.

Finally, we would like to emphasize on the fact that the UM-Thesaurus is an academic publication intended for the spreading of information. Its only objective is to spread knowledge to the largest number of readers. This is the reason why the UM Thesaurus is free of charge for every person or institution. Copies of the contents of the thesaurus can be distributed for free for research or educational purposes, without explicit consent. However, no part of the UM Thesaurus may be reproduced for commercial purposes without permission from the editors.

### Guidelines for the format and submission of manuscripts

Collaborations in every area of Science, Culture and Humanities are published in English and in Spanish in the UM Thesaurus.

The manuscripts and every correspondence must be e-mailed to: **Science and Technology Secretariat**, [thesaurus@unimoron.edu.ar](mailto:thesaurus@unimoron.edu.ar). The material will be reviewed by the UM-Thesaurus Editorial Board.

The manuscripts must be written according to the following guidelines:

- The texts and figures shall be sent by e-mail, as attachments, together with a *cover letter*. The e-mail address from which the manuscript is sent must be personal and belong to the author.
- The original contribution may be sent in Spanish or in English and must be prepared in *Word for Windows*. The Editorial Committee of the UM-Thesaurus will be in charge of the corresponding translation.
- The manuscript shall be typed single-spaced, on letter-sized paper (216 mm x 279 mm), with 2.5 cm margins all around and in 10 point Book Antigua font. The text can be divided in sections under appropriate headings and subheadings.
- **Length of the contribution:** The text must be limited to 6,000 characters (without spaces), including the legends of the Figures and Tables, the references and the footnotes. The Figures and Tables, with their corresponding legends, are to be included in the text. The Tables and/or Figures shall not exceed 3 (Three). The final manuscript must be limited to a total of 3 pages and 200 Kb.
- **Title:** The title must be concise and as short as possible, and it must be written in Capital Letters and boldface. It can be followed by a longer and more informative subtitle.
- **Tables and Figures** (photographs, charts and graphs): They will only be included if strictly necessary to illustrate or make clear the content of the manuscript. Since the UM-Thesaurus is an electronic publication, and due to data transmission characteristics, it is important to make the biggest effort in minimizing the appearance of these elements and, if required, include them in as little detail as possible. The Tables shall be numbered consecutively with Roman numerals whereas the Figures shall be numbered consecutively with Arabic numerals. All of them shall be followed by a

title and the necessary explanations to make the illustration clear enough. The Figures shall be inserted in Bit-Map File Formats having the smallest number of Kb as possible; the formats to be used shall be: GIF and JPEG. However, each of these formats is to be used in different cases: a) **GIF** shall be used whenever the images may represent bar charts, lines or in the case of diagrams and/or drawings in black and white or in plain colors; b) **JPEG** shall be used when the images are photographs or very colorful illustrations.

Besides being included in the text, the **Figures** are to be sent as a separate attachment to the e-mail.

- **References.** Cite and number bibliographic references consecutively, using Arabic numerals in brackets [ ] on the line. List all of them at the bottom of the manuscript, below the corresponding heading. References must contain: initials and surname of the author, year of publication, title of the work, paper or book, and Publisher's data. Here follow some examples:

Example 1. For journal or magazine articles:

*Vanderwolf C.H. (2000). What is the significance of gamma wave activity in the pyriform cortex? Brain Res, 877: 125-133.*

Example 2. For chapters in books:

*Kratskin, I. (1995). Functional anatomy, central connections, and neurochemistry of the mammalian olfactory bulb. In: R. Doty (eds.). Handbook of Olfaction and Gustation. Marcel Dekker, Inc.. New York, pp. 103-126.*

Example 3. For books:

*Kandel, E.; J. Schwartz and T. Jessell (2000). Principles of Neural Science (fourth edition). New York: McGraw-Hill. 1414 pág.*

- **Symbols and Abbreviations:** It is recommended to keep abbreviations to the minimum, considering that they make the text comprehension difficult. If used, they must be defined at first appearance.

- **Footnotes:** If necessary, footnotes may be included to give subsidiary information or other references. They shall be indicated throughout the text with superscript Arabic numerals.

- **Author:** The name of the author shall appear at the bottom of the manuscript, stating his/her specialty or position and place of work or residence. His/her e-mail address may also be included.

- **Style:** Since the purpose of the Thesaurus is to spread information, it is advisable to submit manuscripts concerning new subjects on Science, Culture and Humanities. Regarding scientific works, it is recommended to use a language that may be understood by a non-specialized reader.

The sender will receive an e-mail acknowledging receipt of the manuscript. Every subsequent correspondence will be via e-mail. The manuscripts will be reviewed by the UM Thesaurus editors. According to their opinion, the authors will receive one of the following notifications: **Acceptance** or **Suggested corrections or changes**.
